Who is the Studio for?

The Studio is available to people with a learning disability, mental health conditions, early stage dementia and people on the autistic spectrum.

The Studio also offer 'creative carer sessions' We also recognise that creative art is a great way to take time for yourself away from the pressures of being a Carer.

What happens at the Studio?

The Studio is a great place to people meet new people and to learn and do something new. It's a safe place where, you can indulge yourself in some creative heaven and, if you choose, express emotions, share experiences.

You'll be able to try a range of different art techniques and styles including, mixed media painting, pebble art, glass and silk painting and craftwork, to name just a few!



When is the Studio open?

We offer a range of sessions at the Studio mornings afternoons and evening every week.

How much does it cost ?

It depends on the what the session you want to participate in. We offer half day session at £25.80 and a full day session costs £46.92

If you have a Direct Payment from the council you can use this to purchase a your session. Or if you have funding directly from the local authority, speak to your social worker and they will organise Alternatively you can pass for your session privately.
