Plymouth City Council: capacity and designation of special schools

I am writing to you with important information regarding the October 2018 public consultation that sought views on:

- I. A review of the capital requirements of special schools
- 2. A review of post-16 specialist capacity within the local area
- 3. The designation of special schools
